

MUSICAL THEATRE (CERT) PROGRAM STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES

Upon successful completion of the Theatre Arts program, the graduate will be able to:

1. Apply critical thinking skills to hone the actor's technique.
2. Demonstrate verbal skills in order to execute proper audition techniques.
3. Employ effective writing skills by utilizing appropriate/technical vocabulary and terminology when writing about theatre subjects.
4. Demonstrate mastery over theory and method in elements of voice, movement, script analysis and acting.
5. Demonstrate skill-development experience in set construction, lighting, and sound through the production of a simple flat, and applied proficiency in working a light board and running a sound board.
6. Analyze the impact of historical periods on present day Theatre.
7. Engage with other cultures to sharpen production skills and inform our perspectives, through working with multi-cultural casts, as well as studying plays/scripts that raise diversity and ethical issues.
8. Demonstrate the knowledge and mastery of the trade to enable placement into a baccalaureate institution or for additional career development.
