

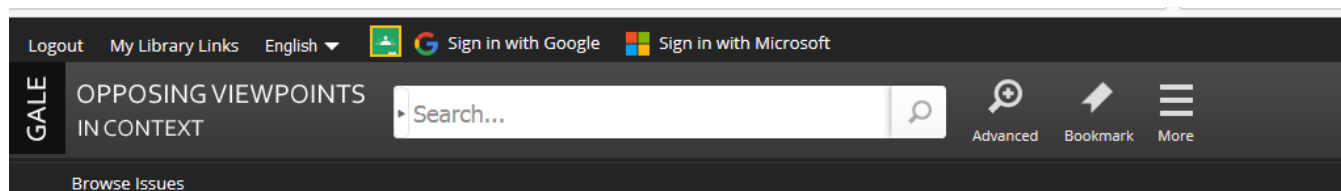

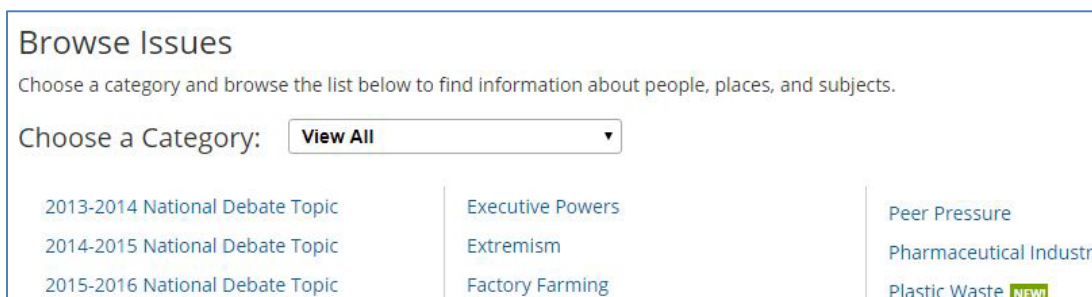
Opposing Viewpoints in Context:

- Provides access to: Book series; Articles from newspapers, magazines, and scholarly journals; Reference resources, statistics, primary documents, and websites.

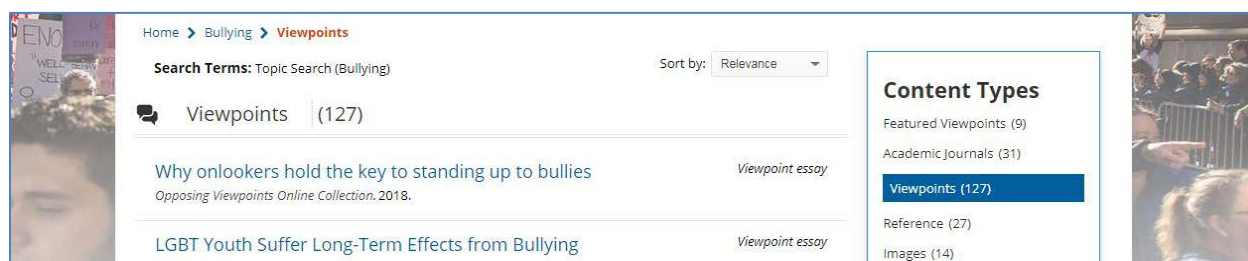
1. Start search by typing your search term(s) in the Search box:
