

The main campus of Genesee Community College is located just two minutes from the city of Batavia in Western New York State. It offers a well-designed, modern campus complete with state-of-the-art technology, a fine and performing arts center, a student union, College Village (a student residential community), and a full service child care center. Nestled in the rural countryside of the Genesee valley, the campus is just 40 minutes between the greater metropolitan areas of Buffalo and Rochester. With more than 7,500 students – including those at six campus centers – Genesee is one of the most highly respected community colleges in the United States. Covering a 2,300-square-mile area over a four-county region (Genesee, Livingston, Orleans, and Wyoming counties), the six Genesee Community College campus centers provide increased access to a wide variety of higher education courses. Many students register for a combination of classes at the different centers according to their preferred home and work schedules, and convenience. Genesee Center for the Arts



The beautiful 328-seat Stuart Steiner Theatre serves as the focal point of Genesee’s Center for the Arts. The theatre and performing arts stage boast quality lighting, sound, stage and mechanical systems, as well as a box office, rehearsal studio, dressing rooms, scene shop, costume shop, and the new Rosalie “Roz” Steiner Art Gallery. The Center hosts dramatic productions, concerts, literary readings, dances, lectures, award ceremonies, and exhibitions.

Genesee’s Center for the Arts houses the Fine Arts, Theatre Arts, Digital Art, and Computerized Drafting programs with modern, well-lit art and ceramic studios, a music library, drafting, and commercial art classrooms.

College Village

Residence Life in Batavia

A three-minute walk from the main campus in Batavia, College Village promises a clean, safe, convenient, and affordable living experience for more than 350 Genesee Community College students. Apartment-style suites feature ample kitchen and dining areas, living rooms and two bedrooms, complete with wireless internet access, cable TV, local and long distance telephone service, a private mailbox, and free laundry facilities. *(The housing rate includes all of these services.)* Safety officers are on duty seven days a week, College Village staff resides on the premises, and all units are secured by state-of-the-art keyless entry systems. As a bonus, a regular calendar of social and educational events is organized each semester, a game room with vending machines and a meeting space for academic clubs is offered, and outdoor basketball and volleyball courts are available. Batavia Campus Directions

From NYS Thruway – Exit 48-Batavia

After tollbooths, turn right at light going north on Route 98. Go over bridge (*and Thruway*) and turn right onto W. Saile Drive. Travel two miles until Saile Drive ends and turn right onto Bank Street Road. Travel ½ mile, cross back over NYS Thruway, and make the first left turn onto R. Stephen Hawley Drive. The College is 1 mile down on the left.

From Route 5 – West

Stay on Route 5 and turn left on Bank Street (*Bank of America is on left corner*). Follow Bank Street through Batavia for almost 2 miles. Turn right onto R. Stephen Hawley Drive. The College is 1 mile down on the left.

From Route 5 – East

Stay on Route 5 and turn right on Bank Street (*just past YMCA*). Follow Bank Street through Batavia for almost 2 miles. Turn right onto R. Stephen Hawley Drive. College is 1 mile down on the left.

From Route 33 E / from 490

Exit 490 onto Route 33 West and travel approximately 10 miles. Turn right onto Batavia–Stafford Townline Road (*Select Collision and Arrow Mart are on each corner*). Turn left onto R. Stephen Hawley Drive.


From Route 33 W / from Buffalo

At the first light in Batavia (*the intersection of Routes 33, 5, and 98*), turn right (*east*) onto Route 5 and 33. Travel 2 blocks, bearing left at the second light. Travel through three more lights and turn left on Bank Street (*Bank of America is on left corner*). Follow Bank Street through Batavia for almost 2 miles. Turn right onto R. Stephen Hawley Drive. The College is 1 mile down on the left.

Route 63 / from the Southeast

From southeast Batavia, turn north onto Cedar Street (*O-AT-KA Milk products and a gas station are on each corner*). At the end of Cedar Street turn left onto Route 5 and immediately turn right onto Route 33. (*Going around Rite Aid Drug Store*). Travel nearly 2 miles to the first light and turn left onto Batavia–Stafford Townline Road (*Select Collision and Arrow Mart are on each corner*). Turn left onto R. Stephen Hawley Drive.
